1. WBS

- a. There should be an WBS ID for every work package (WP).
- b. Consider only WP with at least 4 hours effort effort of a WP should be significant higher (days / weeks)
- c. Sprint 1 Planning, Sprint 2 Progress report Proposal: WP Sprint Management
- d. Org chart: No assignments required

- 2. Milestone plan
 - a. Milestones listed should be visualized in time schedule
 - b. Every criterion should have an id
 - Criterion should be related to content, not in general
 Criteria to check:
 - Submit first sprint report
 - Update status by comment from Milestone1
 - Advisor accept an update status

Feedback



- 3. Time Schedule
 - a. Milestone(s) should be entered
 - b. Proposal: Milestones at least every 4 weeks (compare to sprints)
 → To check, if WP are done
 - c. Dates of Milestones should fit Mismatch: located in CW15 (15.04.), with date 24.03.16
